# Celebrating 75 years of impact



Access Industries is a 100% Australian-owned registered charity (CFN 14342).

This year we celebrate 75 years of achieving our purpose to improve the lives of people with disability by providing meaningful and sustainable employment.

Our supported employees (people with disability) work alongside their peers without disability, in an inclusive, safe and supportive environment.

Of our current 600+ employees state-wide, around 240 are supported employees.

Around 15% of funds required to operate our Disability Employment Services is provided by Government funding.

**We generate the remaining 85% through our business operations and fundraising.**

# Types of corporate giving

1. **Workplace giving.** Employees can give directly to a charity they care about as a pre-tax donation.
2. **Gift matching.** Companies financially match donations that employees make.
3. **Corporate foundations.** NFP bodies funded by a company for the purpose of social investment.
4. **Grants.** A donation made for a distinct purpose, aligning corporate values with grant recipient.
5. **Corporate volunteering.** Develop staff skills and boost your reputation in the local community.



# Where the funds go

It's difficult to quantify a dollar amount to employing one person – everyone is different and requires a greater or lesser level of support or workplace adjustment. What we can quantify is that the more funds we can depend upon, the more planning and developing we can do to employ more people.

This year (2024) we started with a goal of employing 16 more people with disability. By August 2024 we had already reached 26 more people!

Our supported employees are all ages: from school leavers, to young adults, to mature adults, and retirees who have achieved their career goals.

Some examples of need:

- An iPad for individual assistive technology in the workplace - \$1500
- VET course for individual supported training \$2000 – \$6000
- Work Experience Program for students with disability per term - \$3000
- A 10-seater bus to assist supported employees with the transport barrier - \$52,000
- Additional support staff, Welfare Officers, Employment Coaches and continual workplace comfort and safety improvements – ongoing
